

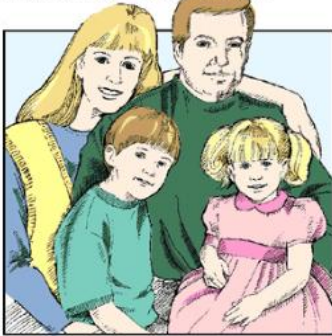

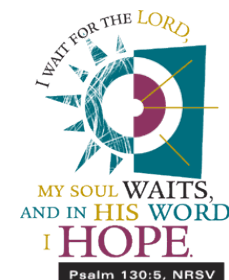

We went to Vernonia, OR, which experienced major flooding in December.
