The Lenten Season
Lent (the word "lent" comes from German or Dutch meaning "Spring" during the Middle ages) is a 40 day preparation for Easter, remembering the gracious gift God has given us. It is seen as a symbol of Christ's 40 days in the wilderness in preparation for His ministry. It is a time when we build a foundation for our Christian walk and faith--building and preparing for the work and ministry the Lord would have for us. It is not simply giving something up like caffeine or sugar. It is much more; it is building on the Rock Jesus Christ, growing in the faith.

I found this quote from Ruth Haley Barton, "The real question of the Lenten season is how will I clear out the junk and garbage in my life so that I can be restored to God in some fresh way? What are the disciplines that will open up space for God to create a clean heart and new spirit in me?" Therefore, Lent is not something that we simply do for 40 days and then celebrate that it is over.

Rather, it is a new beginning demonstrated by Easter and Christ's resurrection. It helps us create a foundation for our entire Christian walk and life before us--a hope and an anticipation of what is yet to come.

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.

Afghanistan: Christian Convert in Hiding After Husband's Murder



Asmaan is in hiding with her children after her husband was murdered. She and her family had fled Afghanistan when the Taliban took over the country. While displaced in another country, they met some Christians and became followers of Christ. But when Asmaan's brother-in-law learned his brother had rejected Islam, he poisoned him, leaving Asmaan a widow with several young children to raise. Without her husband, Asmaan lost the ability to pay her rent and was evicted from her home. Her brother-in-law does not know that Asmaan also became a follower of Jesus. Fearing what he might do if he discovered her new faith, she has gone into hiding along with her children. "Her faith is strong, but she needs God's direction," a front-line worker said.
